Concentration in Portuguese Studies

Eight (8) course units (24 points) are required for the concentration. Students intending to concentrate must have completed the basic Portuguese language sequence at Columbia (or Portuguese 1220 for those who are Spanish speakers), or have passed a Portuguese placement exam.

Distribution of courses:

a. 4 required courses:

- PORT 3101 Conversation about the Portuguese World
- PORT 3300 Advanced Language through Content
- PORT 3330 Introduction to Portuguese Studies
- PORT 3350 Lusophone Africa and Afro-Brazilian Cultures

b. four electives:

- 2 must have PORT designation
- 2 may be taken outside the department but must have Lusophone content.

c. only two courses taught in English may be counted toward the concentration
